Dunnington Parish Council Elections

We need new Parish Council candidates to volunteer to share the workload in moving the Parish forward. Please come along to the meeting and find out more about the job and what we do. The existing Parish Council’s term of office ends on May 7th. There are currently 11 councillors and 2 vacancies. Nomination forms can be obtained from the Parish Council or City of York Council and require the signature of the candidate and one other parishioner.

If 14 or more members of the Parish put their names forward there will be an election on Thursday 7th May at the same time as the York City Council elections and the General Election.

ANTI-SOCIAL DOG FOULING

Whilst the vast majority of dog owners in our village are responsible, a small minority do not pick up after their dog leaving our streets and verges unsightly, dirty and a hotbed for disease. This issue generates many complaints so we are asking you to help to eradicate this antisocial behaviour.

If you see dog foul in and around the village.

Call City of York Council Street Cleaning Department on 01904 551551 giving the location and they aim to clean it up on the same day.

If you see a dog owner not picking up after them.

Call City of York Council Neighbourhood Enforcement on 01904 551530. Provide as much information as you can; date, time, location, description of dog and owner and if known the address of owner. They will not identify you but *offenders will be either issued a fixed penalty notice or prosecuted.*
