Cemetery Advisory Group

Definition

The Cemetery Advisory Group is made up of a maximum of 4 Parish Council members and the Parish Clerk. A minimum of 3 members are needed for a quorum.

The Cemetery Advisory Group will invite experts to advise the group when appropriate

The Cemetery is owned and managed by Dunnington Parish Council

Purpose

The Cemetery is managed on a day to day basis by the Parish Clerk

The Dunnington Cemetery Advisory Group will support the Parish Clerk on decision making when required

To ensure the Cemetery complies with statutory regulations

To keep the Rules and Regulations up to date and review annually

To ensure the Cemetery is maintained to an acceptable standard

To progress Phase 2 of the Cemetery

Terms of Reference

The Cemetery Group will meet 3 times a year (every 4 months) and on an ad-hoc basis when required with a minimum of 3 members attending the meeting

Notes will be taken at each meeting

Any proposals or recommendations will be presented to the full Parish Council for discussion or approval before implementation

The group will have no budget but will be able to propose expenditure to the Finance, Strategy and Audit Committee or full council.

Cemetery charges will be reviewed annually and recommendations made to the full Parish Council
